

SCIENCE MEETS RELIGION

In the beginning, before our known universe began, there was space. There was a lot of empty space, but still other universes existed. These were run by single cells which were filled with small particles like atoms that were able to transform themselves into anything, but because these cells, although few in number, were the master cells they were the only cells that contained the particles that could be transformed into either solid or non-solid matter. The easiest way to describe these particles would be to suggest that they were no more than the size of a chromosome. One such cell approximately 15 billion years ago had just started its new life and had to have a universe to manage and so was given a bubble of new space.

If Hobi created *Gomawobe* then where did Hobi come from? It was time for some questions to be asked but would the answers given to those questions upset us or if we in fact found we were travelling in the wrong direction would we change our lives to put things right? Do we care enough about our future existence and development to sacrifice anything or any way of our current lifestyle.

When the organisation of believers in *Gomawobe* was first set up they called themselves "Sciligions" pronounced "Si-le-jons" The creators and founders of Sciligion is a man and woman simply known jointly as Patden. The conditions to becoming a member are as follows.

Rule one. Never try to inflict your belief on others. You may tell the story of *Gomawobe* but must not persist that your way is the only way and that all other ways are wrong.

Rule two. It is preferred that each follower wear the seven colours of the rainbow about their person at all times. There is no order that these must take place in or that they should all be in one place. It is a preference only that these are worn and a rule that all followers must respect another followers right to choose. A person can still be a *Gomawobe* follower and not wear the colours at all times.

Rule three. The day of thanks to *Gomawobe* our creator is Tuesday and on that day it is essential that any gathering that takes place in order to give that thanks all participants must without fail wear their colours where they can be seen. If this rule is not followed your chance for transference is lessened. However this rule only applies when attending a gathering or meeting to give thanks.

Rule four. Relationships that are permissible are those between male and female, male and male, and female and female as long as all participants are of legal age. These relationships must also be acceptable without malice by all other sciligion followers.

Rule five. A sciligion must never take a life of any creature unless it is essential for survival.

Rule six. A sciligion is allowed to believe in a guardian. This guardian is the mental guardian that a sciligion can use other than our creator *Gomawobe* to consol their thoughts or for reassurance. Some people use a late relative or icon, these are permissible.

Rule Seven. In an effort to prolong life and preserve the planet it is required that no products produced from cattle should be consumed on a Tuesday. This rule also applies to the purchasing of such products unless your job in your place of employment requires you to do so, however such purchasing must not be for your own requirements.

It is believed that PatDen were both called to a meeting with *Gomawobe* after several requests were made through worship. Although *Gomawobe* could not actually be present because of the enormity of it's size it could still communicate with PatDen through speech. The main basics of existence have all been explained and were found through the questions asked by PatDen. It has since been discovered that the following questions were also asked and answered.

Question: How many of you are there?

Answer: There is our creator "Hibi" then came "Ismuka". Next came "Godolova" then finally myself "*Gomawobe*".

Question: Do all of you have a universe to manage?

Answer: Yes, you would see it as a garden and just like a garden things grow, then flourish, then die.

Question: If you all have a garden wheat does Hobi have to manage?

Answer: Hobi manages the entire space we simply attempt to fill some parts of it.

Question: Are you all infalable?

Answer: No, although since our existence came about none of us has yet died, it is thought that Hobi will one day deteriorate. Since the creation of Hobi there has been a steady decline. If our predictions are correct Hobi has only another 10,000 trillion earth years of life.

Question: Once Hobi is gone what have you all decided will happen?

Answer: I will become Hobi. You see I am the first produced that is able to reproduce our own. "Ismuka" and "Godolova" are not able to do this.

Question: Will you still be known as *Gomawobe* ?

Answer: No. It has been decided that "Hobi" becomes a title as Hobi was the first of us.

Question: If you become Hobi what will happen to our universe?

Answer: If by then you have all managed to sustain life and learned to live side by side you may be capable of looking after your own universe until I can produce a cell to become your new manager. However it is thought that greed will prevent this happening and you will destroy yourselves before then. Your planet will still remain though. Creatures from other planets that have not succumbed to such greed and possessiveness will be guided by me to your almost empty planet. Amongst all extinctions there are always survivors. Those survivors will only be the ones that will mix with their new arrivals.

Question: If you can control what happens how can you just stand by and watch such death and destruction?

Answer: Since almost nothing survives without something dying then death is inevitable. However death through survival and death through greed are not the same. To kill to eat, whether plant or animal is necessary. You have interfered in the course of nature yourselves and suffered the

Will you destroy their existence and in so doing destroy your own? I cannot take sides so will not be looked upon to help or destroy your enemies for you are also their enemies. Just as you think you are right they also think they are right. Communication and tolerance are the key. You and your followers have been chosen to spread the word but do so carefully and never force anyone into your way of life or belief. To do so could cause conflict. Teach by all means but people must make their own decisions. You think population control is wrong then complain of overcrowding and famine. Think of your size, space and capabilities. Think also of the equation between time and growth. To destroy all else to make way for yourselves will only lead to your own destruction. If this happens I can start again anew, you do not have and never will have that power.

Question: Is there such a thing as life after death?

Answer: You are all here through transference. Ismuka created the first universe and thus the first life forms. All life forms in all universes look different. Once we all had our own life forms we had a meeting because some were simply out of control. Our meeting depicted that those that were good enough had their character, not their shape or physical structure sent by transference to a higher level. This would be from me to Godolova then to the ultimate paradise which is the universe of Ismuka. Since greed has been a characteristic of all intelligent life few remain for long with Ismuka. If they go wring they come back here and start again.

Question: Are there such things as ghosts?

Answer: You must decide that for yourself. If by the time you die you have not earned transference then you must stay in the same universe but on a different planet. Your character is reborn albeit in a different life form. However some characters may feel that they have been unfairly judged and will not accept their fate. They become angry and unsettled looking for justice. Most find that justice and move on. Some though refuse to go and remain for hundreds of years never caring to reach the paradise universe of Ismuka. If a character can be classed as a ghost then yes they do exist. A character will sometimes show itself as a see through form but only to those it believes can help. If a person dismisses totally in their minds that these characters exist then they are of no use to the character and so it will not reveal itself to them. Some characters simply can't accept their fate and become restless and mischievous. You have named these poltergeist. It is usually harmless and eventually moves on. I do have the power to remove these but will only do so if asked by a genuine *Gomawobe* believer wearing the true colours on a Tuesday.

Question: Are there other life forms on other planets in our universe?

Answer: Some questions can be answered because they do not interfere with your progress. Discovery is learning, curiosity is learning. If I answered yes to your question which by the way has been answered then your next question would be "where". As I have said before I will not interfere.

Question: Does character only apply to the human form or is it possible for animals to earn transference.

Answer: All forms of life are character. Some are sent back from Ismuka two levels to my universe. Some are sent back one level to Godolova. Equally some go forward in the same manner. All though are given a term to prove themselves. If their term is a short one then they may come back as something with a short life.

Question: How do you know all that happens everywhere in your universe.

Answer: Decipals are elected before entering a life form. Once they die we get their information. Although it has been elected it has no knowledge of this once it becomes a life form. Some of these decipals return several times by choice because to do so would earn a place with Ismuka for eternity. These are few in number and they become our council. When they think something should be changed somewhere they put that suggestion to us individually and we have the final say about what will happen. Any that tries to alter that decision are sent with the characters of no hope to the open universe of Hobi and are banished forever and just become carbon. They will eventually be compressed into another ball. Hobi will one day reproduce again and that ball will become another universe. Those characters eventually becoming the stars and planets. Answer: No, you see human beings always look for creators or Gods to have their own basic shape. They never take into account that everything we do is done by the power of thought. We are so far advanced in human terms that we have no need for limbs. Our food is derived from gases. Also our size is far too large for the human brain to comprehend.

You now know everything you need to know. It is now up to you and your congregations to go forward and spread the word. Finding and electing your own recruits to teach people the origins of life and what is needed to progress on to paradise. Ismuka is waiting but beware if you become a "no hoper" you will be banished forever to roam lonely or burn for eternity.
